#### **November Mayor Message**

At the October City Council meeting an ordinance update (91.40 Farm Animals) was adopted; The updated ordinance creates an exception for chickens within the city district. The following requirements are to be met: No more than 4 chickens shall be kept on the premise (parcel).

Chickens shall be kept in a coop or attached coop run/enclosed at all times.

No roosters shall be kept on the premises.

The premises must be located in a single and two family residential (R-1) or limited multiple-family residential (R-2) zoning district.

The premises must have a lot area of at least five 5,000 square feet.

A license is purchased annually at the city office. Cost of license is \$10.00.

NOTE: Prior to the <u>November 12<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting</u>, at 6pm, a public forum will be held to share the preliminary findings of data collection and analysis from the energy grant. Hope you can join the meeting!


